**SUBJECT:** Presentation on 2013 Community Safety Survey and 2014 Policing Priorities and Strategies

**Introduction**

In September and October, the Maplewood Police Department sponsored an online community safety survey. One hundred eighty (180) people responded to the survey, providing a broad range of input on such issues as perceptions of neighborhood safety, levels of police patrol, and community safety priorities. While not a compellingly large survey response, the data generated was nonetheless valuable and corroborative of department statistical and citizen complaint data.

This presentation, which will be reviewed and distributed at the Workshop session, will provide a survey overview and findings, along with the planned 2014 policing priorities and preliminary strategies.
